The benefits of the Direct Anterior Hip Replacement versus the traditional approach include:

- Decreased hospital stay and quicker rehabilitation
- Smaller incision and reduced muscle disruption allowing for a shorter recovery time and less scarring.
- Potential for less blood loss, less time in surgery and reduced post-operative pain.
- Due to the minimally invasive nature, patients may have a decreased risk of hip dislocation after surgery.
- May allow for a more natural return to normal function and activity compared to the posterior approach.
